

Staging Tips

Throughout the house:

- ___1. Walls should be painted a neutral color
- _____2. Open all drapes, pull up blinds and shades and let in the sunlight
 - 3. Create a positive mood. Turn on lights, day of night, and install higher wattage light bulbs to show your home brightly
 - ____4. Remove clutter from each room to make it appear larger
 - 5. Show rooms as they should be used, a defined purpose. example, remove a desk from the dining room and place a dining table. Stage all rooms as if they have a purpose
- 6. If you have a fireplace, highlight it in your decorating
- ____7. Replace the carpet if it does not clean up well.
- 8. Keep your home dusted and vacuumed at all times
- 9. Have a family "game plan" to get home to prepare for a showing or make pet arrangements quickly if necessary
- ____10. Air out out your home for at least a half hour prior to showings, if possible
- 11 Lightly spray your house with air freshener so that is have a chance to defuse before the buyer arrives
- ____12. Put family photos in storage
- 13. Improve traffic flow through every room by removing unnecessary furniture

____14. Create feeling of a spacious entry area by using decorative accents and removing unnecessary furniture

- ____15. Putty over and paint any nail holes or other mishaps in the walls
- 16. Paint all interior walls a neutral color to brighten the home and make it look bigger. Adding a small amount of vanilla extract in your paint will make your home smell fresh
- ____17. Repair of replace any damaged or loose wall paper
- ____18. Clean fans and light fixtures
- ____19. Wash all windows inside and out
- _____20. Use plants in transitional areas of your home
- ____21. Make the most of you attics potential
- 22. Remove and/or hide excess extension cords or exposed wires
- ____23. Open doors to areas you want potential buyers to see such as walk in closets, pantries, attics
- ____24. Remove all smoke ad pet odors
- ____25. Repair or replace banisters and handrails
 - __26. Use the rule of 3 when decorating tables, mantel or picture groups

In the Kitchen

- 1. Microwave a small dish of vanilla twenty minutes before a showing and place it in an obscure place
- 2. Highlight an eat-in area of your kitchen with a table set for dinner
- _____3. The kitchen and bathrooms should always be spotless
- _____4. Expand your counter space by removing small appliances

In the Bedrooms

- ____1. Create a master suite effect in your decorating
- 2. Depersonalize bedrooms and decorate in a neutral theme
- 3. Make sure that the beds are made and linens are clean
- 4. Organize your closets, remove unnecessary items and put them in storage. All hangers should be going in the same direction

In the Bathrooms

_____1. Do not leave towels around and wipe down the sinks and shower areas after each use

- 2. Re-caulk the tub if the caulk is not sparkling
- 3. Repair or replace broken tiles in the shower/tub
- 4. Replace shower curtains and keep them clean
- 5. Put out fresh towels on racks or roll up on counter. Display decorative soaps

Outside

- 1. Keep the yard moved and raked at all times
- 2. Use flowering plants to dress up the yard, walkway and patio
- _____3. Remove all toys, bicycles, tools, unsightly patio furniture and trash from the yard
- 4. Porches, steps, verandas, balconies, patios and other extensions of our house should be kept uncluttered, swept and in good condition
- 5. Paint all entrance doors

_____6. Make sure the garage door opens easily. Fix and paint the garage door if necessary

7. Clean and shine all hardware and accessories indoors and out (door knobs, knockers, lamps, mail box, address numbers, etc)

- 8. Trees and shrubs should be trimmed and pruned
- 9. Use a new doormat
- _____10. Be sure the front doorbell is in good working order
- ____11. Be sure the front door and screen door works perfectly
- 12. Repair rotten wood on door frames or facial boards.
- 13. Freshen up your flower beds with pine straw
